Options in June

If schools are not closed for snow or another reason and students have an appropriate amount of instructional time, then the superintendent may shorten the school year by one or two days. There are three options for June:

option A
 June 13-14: high school exams, three-hour early release for all students and teacher workdays; June 14: last day of school for students; June 15: last teacher workday

option B
 June 12-13: high school exams, three-hour early release for all students and teacher workdays; June 13: last day of school for students; June 14: last teacher workday

option C
 June 11-12: high school exams, three-hour early release for all students and teacher workdays; June 12: last day of school for students; June 13: last teacher workday

2017-2018 calendar of Petersburg City Public Schools

Overview

The calendar is designed to position students to succeed academically, meet state requirements and contain adequate instructional time so that it does not have to be revised after each snow day.

There are 11 **three-hour early release days** for students. Four of these days provide teachers time for professional development; seven of these days are for planning, grade preparation or parent-teacher conferences.

Parent-teacher conferences will be scheduled Oct. 4 and March 7 with the last conferences ending at 7 p.m.

Holidays apply to all employees with one exception: For 12-month employees, only the first two days of spring break (April 2-3) are holidays.

The School Board retains the right to modify this calendar. The superintendent determines makeup time, which may include lengthening instructional days, the loss of the Feb. 19 holiday and the loss of some early-release days.

If schools are not closed for snow or another reason and students have an appropriate amount of instructional time, then the superintendent may shorten the school year by one or two days. There are three possible options for the end of the year:

option A

- June 13-14: high school exams, three-hour early release for all students and teacher workdays
- June 14: last day of school for students
- June 15: last teacher workday

Option A includes 181 instructional days for students: 44 in the first nine weeks, 48 in the second, 41 in the third and 48 in the fourth. Teacher workdays total 187; workdays for new teachers total 192.

option B

- June 12-13: high school exams, three-hour early release for all students and teacher workdays
- June 13: last day of school for students
- June 14: last teacher workday

Option B includes 180 instructional days for students: 44 in the first nine weeks, 48 in the second, 41 in the third and 47 in the fourth. Teacher workdays total 186; workdays for new teachers total 191.

option C

- June 11-12: high school exams, three-hour early release for all students and teacher workdays
- June 12: last day of school for students
- June 13: last teacher workday

Option C includes 179 instructional days for students: 44 in the first nine weeks, 48 in the second, 41 in the third and 46 in the fourth. Teacher workdays total 185; workdays for new teachers total 190.
